

Beginner Guitar Riffs on One String

Today, I thought we could look at a few songs in one lesson. In fact, we're only going to be looking at the RIFFs from particular songs.

A Riff, is a repeated pattern normally played by the guitar, bass guitar or keyboard. But can generally be played by other instruments too. A famous example could be The White Stripes song 'Seven Nation Army'. The main guitar part repeats round and round and could be considered a RIFF.

In today's tutorial I have decided to give you a lesson that will offer up several songs in one sitting. There are so many short recognisable guitar riffs that are easy and fun to learn, and because they are recognisable they can also feel really rewarding to learn. All songs are played on one string. Your Low E string is the one that we will be using. Some of these Riffs might take you some time to get used, but to be honest that will make it more rewarding once you have learned it.
