Notes on the Balalaika Fingerboard

1st position

Notes on 1st string: A (open string), B (2^{ND} fret, 1^{st} finger), C (3^{rd} fret, 2^{nd} finger), D (4^{th} fret, 3^{rd} finger), E (5^{th} fret, 4^{th} /little finger)




Notes E – A ("high A") on 1st string & Scale of A minor (natural)

New technique: shift from 1^{st} position (notes A-D) to 4^{th} position (from E on 7^{th} fret played with 1^{st} finger), then -

New notes:

F (8thfret, 2nd finger), G (10th fret,3rd finger), "high A" (12th fret, 4th/little finger)



Written like this (numbers refer to fingers of left hand)



Note – in this exercise, the first 4 bars show the 8 notes of the A minor scale; bars 5 and 6 (between the repeat signs) show the A minor "arpeggio".

Signs used: 1. *Pizzicato* - pluck the string with the right hand thumb

2. Repeat signs – play the part between the signs again, e.g.

equal to be repeated>

(if there is no sign marking the beginning, repeat from the start of the piece)

3. End bar - marks the end of the piece
