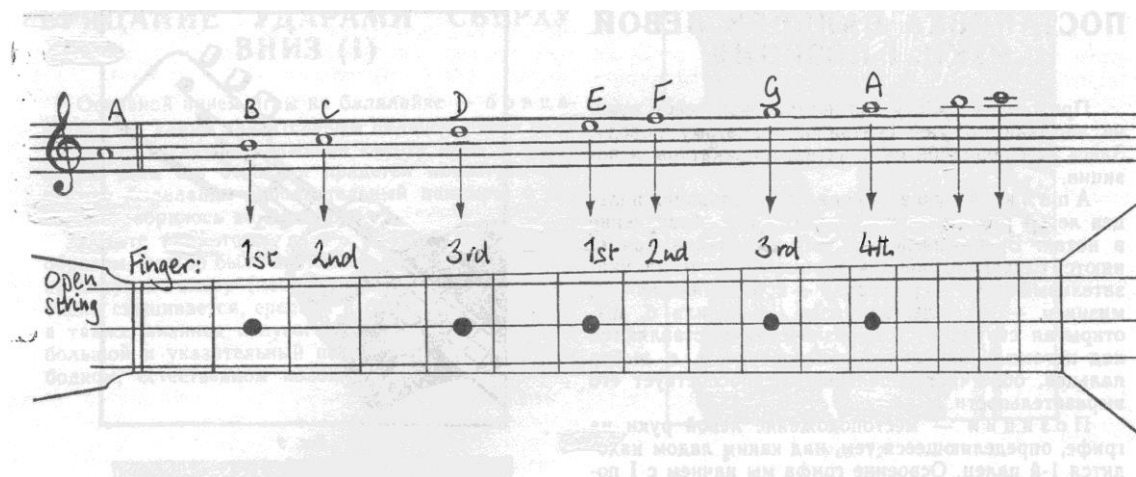



## A minor Scale (recap from Lesson 2)

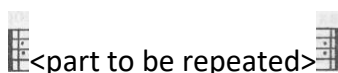


Written like this (numbers refer to fingers of left hand)




Note – in this exercise, the first 4 bars show the 8 notes of the A minor scale;  
bars 5 and 6 (between the repeat signs) show the A minor “arpeggio”.

Signs used: 1. *Pizzicato*  - pluck the string with the right hand thumb  
2. *Repeat signs* – play the part between the signs again, e.g.



(if there is no sign marking the beginning, repeat from the start of the piece)

3. End bar -  marks the end of the piece
