

# Implementing and embedding effective oracy practice across the school.

1

Create an understanding of what oracy is using evidence informed learning for staff, cementing why it is important and how you want it to feature within your school's culture.

2

Carry out a whole-school oracy self-assessment to understand your starting point with an Oracy Lead at the helm. Encourage Staff to recognise their starting points.

3

Learn about effective oracy practice under the criteria of **learning to talk, talking to learn** and **learning about talk** developing an inclusive, progressive scheme of work.

4

Develop pupils' understanding of oracy alongside the teaching of specific skills through discrete lessons to create a bespoke, uniform approach.

5

Identify how to maximise oracy across the curriculum and carry out CPD with staff to create a progressive, collaborative approach **e.g. carrying out tasks with oral outcomes to assess learning.**

6

Develop the school culture of oracy by engaging all stakeholders, championing talk through wider experiences and using oracy for assessment.
