What Are Cookies?

When we provide services, we want to make them easy, useful, and reliable. Where services are delivered on the internet, this sometimes involves placing small amounts of information on your device (such as your computer or mobile phone). These include small text files known as cookies.

These pieces of information are used to improve services for you by:

- Enabling a service to recognize your device so you don't have to give the same information several times during one task.
- Recognizing that you may already have given a username and password so you don't need to do it for every web page requested.
- Measuring how many people are using services, so they can be made easier to use and ensure there is enough capacity to keep them fast.

One Education's Use of Cookies

While session tokens are used to securely manage your current visit and form submissions, they do not collect personal information to build behavioral profiles or harvest data for secondary marketing purposes.

Cookie Name	Type	What It Does	Expiration
Request Verification Token	Strictly Necessary (Session)	Protects users against CSRF (Cross-Site Request Forgery) attacks. It is a standard security cookie required for the safe operation of forms and pages.	Deleted automatically when you close your browser.
ASP.NET_Session-Id / sessionId	Strictly Necessary (Session)	Required for forms and pages within the site to operate correctly by ensuring data is securely delivered to the correct user session.	Deleted automatically when you close your browser.
